Employed Student Nurses (ESNs/ESPNs):	Leaders:
 Have successfully completed Year 2 of a British Columbia College of Nurses & Midwives entry- level RN or RPN education program or equivalent nursing program from another jurisdiction. Meet eligibility criteria for Employed Student registration with British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives. Performs activities within the competencies obtained through a recognized education program and within the Island Health ESN Limits and Conditions or Island Health ESPN Limits and Conditions. Performs activities authorized by the RN, RPN, or NP providing regulatory supervision and seeks help as required. Creates a learning plan utilizing the ESN/ESPN CAPE Tool and review/update with leadership regularly. 	 and provide regulatory supervision in alignment with <u>Island Health ESN Limits</u> <u>and Conditions</u> or <u>Island Health ESPN</u> <u>Limits and Conditions</u>. Ensure ESNs/ESPNs do not have a position on the same unit as their practicum placement; may lead to role confusion. Establish a regular process for updating
	learning plans and utilizing the CAPE Tool with ESNs/ESPNs.
