

COMMUNITY VIRTUAL CARE



Community Virtual Care is a free, innovative Island Health program that uses remote patient monitoring, virtual visits and telephone to support clients and caregivers to better manage a range of health conditions from the comfort of home.

Clients DO NOT require a referral from a primary care provider.

Conditions may include:

- heart failure
- diabetes
- hypertension
- chronic kidney disease
- chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
- palliative or progressive, life-limiting illnesses
- wildfire smoke inhalation
- influenza
- heat-related illness
- COVID-19

Receive 1:1 support from registered nurses who monitor symptoms and coach clients to improve their ability to manage their health.

Community Virtual Care also provides a support program for family caregivers, focussed on strengthening emotional well being and coping skills.

Free training, support and health monitoring equipment is provided.

Community Virtual Care services are available 12 hours per day, 7 days per week.
